Phase 3 Trial of Dichloroacetate (DCA) for Pyruvate Dehydrogenase Complex Deficiency (PDCD)

University of Florida is sponsoring a federally funded Phase 3 Trial of Dichloroacetate (DCA) for Pyruvate Dehydrogenase Complex Deficiency (PDCD) with 9 participating academic clinical trial sites throughout the United States. We are actively recruiting children, aged 6 months through 17 years with a known genetic mutation in genes associated with PDCD – **PDHA1, PDHB, DLAT, PDHX, PDP1, PDP2**.
